

Additional Info

- **Tournament Waters:** Lake Norfolk and any creeks and canals connecting to Lake Norfolk. Only that water open to ALL public fishing will be considered tournament waters. Any waters closed to public fishing will be closed to this tournament's contestants.
- **Fish Creel and Length Limit:** 5 fish per boat, 15" on Largemouth Bass, Smallmouth Bass and Spotted Bass. Mouth closed – tail fanned.
- **Fishing License:** Fishing License – Arkansas is required. If you plan on fishing Missouri waters or possessing fish while running through Missouri waters, then a Missouri license is required. *For anglers who reside in Arkansas or Missouri, a white river permit will suffice for your fishing license.*
- **Fishing License Ages:** Fishing License Age Requirements– Arkansas if of age, 16 years or older, Fishing License is required. Should you be under the age of 16, then no license is required. Missouri if 16 years or older, Fishing License is required. Should you be under the age of 16, then no license is required.
