

## 2023 High School Guidelines

### General Information

- Entry Fee is \$50
- Entry fee is non-refundable/non-transferable once a team is accepted into a tournament
- Partner changes are due 30 days prior to first day of competition, no partner changes after, if someone cannot fish within 30 days of the tournament then their partner fishes alone
- Boat captain changes due at latest 10 days prior to the tournament.
- If a team is on the wait list, they can cancel at any time and receive a full refund of their entry fee
- Any team not accepted into a tournament will be canceled the week of the tournament after registration and will be refunded.
- All refunds will be paid back to the card used for the deposit unless B.A.S.S. is notified that the card has been canceled/expired, and then a refund check will be processed.
- Full field for each tournament is 250 teams

### Waivers & Tax Paperwork

- Each angler must complete a waiver and W9 prior to practice
- The waiver and W9 are combined document to be completed through our online e-signature company.
- The waiver and W9 document is a two-step process to be completed first by the parent/guardian and then by the angler.
- The boat captain must complete a waiver
- The waiver/W9 document only needs to be completed once per season.
