DATES TOURNAMENT WATERS OFF-LIMITS FOR MARSHALS There are no off limits for Marshals

TOURNAMENT WATERS
Sabine River and all rivers, creeks and canals connecting to the Sabine River inside the boundaries listed below. Only that water open to ALL public fishing will be considered tournament waters. Any waters closed to public fishing will be closed to this tournament’s contestants.
Texas Counties – Chambers, Galveston, Hardin, Jefferson, Liberty (South of U.S. Hwy 90), Newton, & Orange including any public waters on border with adjacent counties. Both TX & LA River Shoreline of the Sabine River bank to bank to Toledo Bend Dam.
NO FISHING in any LA backwaters beyond the Sabine River that includes no cuts, creeks, rivers, inlets, coves, bayous or any channel cut throughs. Treat all those areas as a brick wall from point to point. However, you can navigate through a channel cut through.

FISHING LICENSE Texas fishing license is required including a saltwater stamp.
