

2024 Bassmaster Opens Overview – Division 1, Division 2, and Division 3

- 2025 Bassmaster Classic berth to the Pro Division winner of each St. Croix Bassmaster Opens tournament*
- Three (3) events in each St. Croix Bassmaster Opens Division
- ALL CASH payout for pro angler and non-boater
- 14 Day Off-limits/No information period
- Official practice is five days prior to each event (see official rules)
- Mandatory check-in day before the start of competition. Schedule times to be sent.
- Advertised payout based on 225 boats. Adjusted for actual field size.
- Random pairings between Pro and Non-boater

2024 Bassmaster Opens Series Format

Pro \$2,000 entry (\$800 deposit)

- Full field days one and two
- Top 10 pros fish day three
- Weights carry over all three days
- Some pros may fish alone depending on non-boater participation
- Five (5) fish limit

Non-boater \$475 entry (\$200 deposit)

- Full field days one and two
- Weights carry over
- Three (3) fish limit
- Winner and Top 40 checks awarded following Day Two weigh-in

2024 Bassmaster Opens Payout (based on fields of 225)

2024 Bassmaster Elite Qualifier

- To be eligible, pro-anglers must be registered in all 9 events before Day One of event One. EQ anglers must compete in all eligible tournament days. If an angler misses a tournament, they will lose their EQ status.
- The top 9 in Elite Qualifier AOY standings will earn a berth to the Bassmaster Elite Series.
- If any angler inside the top 9 in Elite Qualifier AOY Standings has already qualified for the 2025 Bassmaster Elite Series via the 2024 Elite Series, B.A.S.S. will work down the Elite Qualifier list.

B.A.S.S. reserves the right to work down respective Opens points standings.

^{*}Must COMPETE as a pro angler in all three tournaments in division and fish all days eligible to qualify, unless approved by Tournament Director. If a winner is unqualified or double qualified the additional spot will go to the Bassmaster Elite Series AOY list

- Elite Qualifier Angler of the Year \$45,000
 - 2nd \$12,000; 3rd \$10,000; 4th \$9,000; 5th \$8,000; 6th \$7,000; 7th \$6,000; 8th \$5,000; 9th \$4,500; 10th \$3,500
 - Total AOY payout \$110,000
- Non-Boater Overall Angler of the Year
 - Entries into Pro Division of Choice for the next season.
