REGISTRATION REMINDER: All anglers must CHECK-IN in person with B.A.S.S. **TOURNAMENT CHECK-IN / BRIEFING DATE** July 10, 2024 Staff onsite. This will be the only registration period. See Rule No. 4. Time slots will be emailed tournament week. Virtual - All Contestants must view. **TOURNAMENT BRIEFING** July 6 – July 10. ALL COMPETITORS MUST BE OFF TOURNAMENT WATERS @ 12:00 PM LOCAL TIME **OFFICIAL PRACTICE DAYS** ON CHECK-IN DAY. During official practice, competitors may only fish with other competitors per Rule 3ii. Off-limits will begin on Saturday June 22 and extend through Saturday, July 6 @ safelight. During this **PRE-TOURNAMENT OFF-LIMITS** time you are not allowed on tournament waters. Lake St. Clair and all rivers, creeks and canals connecting to Lake St. Clair. Only water open to ALL **TOURNAMENT WATERS** public fishing will be considered tournament waters. Any waters closed to public fishing will be closed to this tournament's contestants. Including the Southern portion of Lake Huron – See Boundary Map Including the Western portion of Lake Erie – See Boundary Map **FISHING LICENSE** - Michigan License required - https://www.mdnr-elicense.com/Welcome/Default.aspx. -If fishing Ontario waters you must purchase an Outdoors Card and an Ontario Sport Fishing License **NOT** a conservation license – https://www.ontario.ca/page/fishing -If fishing Ohio waters, you must have Ohio License https://ohiodnr.gov/buy-and-apply/hunting-fishingboating/fishing-resources/fishing-licenses - If fishing or traversing through the Walpole Island Territory, you must have a pleasure craft permit and fishing permit. https://www.walpoleislandfirstnation.ca/hunting-and-fishing

Balance deadline dates are the dates the balances are due. You will not receive any further notices on balance due. It is the anglers' responsibility to be sure payment is made by the deadline date.

Deposits are non-refundable and non-transferable regardless of date of cancellation. Any balance of the entry fee paid in excess of the deposit will be refunded only if notification is made to the B.A.S.S. Tournament Department prior to the balance deadline date. Anglers on waiting list should not pay balance until contacted by tournament department.
